On January 13, 1964, a Boeing B-52D bomber, "Buzz One Four" experienced severe wind turbulence causing structural failure of the vertical tail section. The aircraft went out of control.

The order to abandon the aircraft was given and 4 of the 5 crewmen were able to eject. The 5th crewman was unable to eject. Buzz One Four, armed with 2 Mk 53 nuclear bombs, crashed in blizzard conditions near the border between Garrett County and Allegany County, Maryland (near Lonaconing). Three of the crewmen did not survive.


